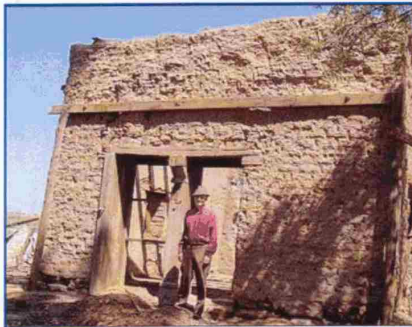
TOWN HERITAGE MONTH 2009
